ROBOTIC ASSISTED JOINT REPLACEMENT

Joint replacement operations have an excellent success rate, helping patients who were previously crippled by painful and stiff arthritic joints walk again. During the operation the surgeon cuts and prepares the bone, then places the new prosthesis as accurately as possible in position using a series of jigs, saws and other instruments. Our aim is always to be as accurate as possible, but most studies show some variability in how well we achieve this.

Our attempts at accuracy are now helped by the availability of a surgical robot that helps with the planning and execution of the operation. The most commonly used robot in Australia is the MAKO robot. This has been used for over 10 years in the USA but has been available in Australia for partial knee replacements for 2 years, total hip replacement for 1 year, and is now available for total knee replacement as well.

In 2017 the AOA national joint replacement registry showed a one-year revision rate of the MAKO partial knee replacement to be 0.8%, which is the lowest of all listed prosthesis. The average for all prosthesis was 2.2%.

MHK surgeons have performed the first robotic total knee replacement in Victoria, as well as performing the first robotic total hip replacement and partial knee replacement at the Epworth Hospital.

Mr van Bavel has also been invited to speak at a national AOA conference in March on the use of robotics for joint replacement.
